The verdict and sentence for the 181 Enlisted Personnel listed above imposed by the military court is stated below, verbatim:

FINDINGS

As to the Charges and Specifications in the three (3) lesser offenses of violating Article of War 63 (Disrespect toward the President), Article of War 64 (Disrespect toward superior Officer), and Article of War 97 (Conduct prejudicial to good order and military discipline): GUILTY

SENTENCE

- (a) For Accused with rank of E-7, E-6, E-5, and E-4 - demotion by 3 ranks plus forfeiture of 2/3 of basic pay for 3 months plus 1 year confinement.
- (b) For Accused with rank of E-3 - demotion by 2 ranks plus forfeiture of 2/3 of basic pay for 3 months plus forfeiture of 2/3 of basic pay for 3 months plus 1 year confinement
- (c) For Accused with rank of E-2 - demotion by 1 rank plus forfeiture of 2/3 of basic pay for 4 months plus 1 year confinement.
- (d) For the Accused with the rank of E-1 - forfeiture of 2/3 pay for 6 months plus 1 year confinement

The Special General Court-Martial recommended that when implementing the abovementioned sentence to one (1) year of confinement, time already served in confinement should be considered. The Special General Court-Martial also recommended that, under the circumstances, all the above-named Accused Enlisted Personnel will be ordered immediately released from confinement.

The Accused also submitted a request for clemency and mitigation of the sentence imposed by the Special General Court-Martial.

The sentence was promulgated on 11 May 2005.



## II. AFP OFFICERS

### Group A: People of the Philippines versus Major Perfecto Ragil PA, et al.

- Major Ragil was not even indicted; he was a State Witness from the start, including before the Makati RTC.
- Officers not present at Oakwood but were indicted because they were included in the list of "Magdalo Members" in the computer diskette recovered by AFP intelligence operatives from the Oakwood Premier Suites hotel right after the incident.
- All these Accused were recommended by the Prosecution Panel for dropping of charges by way of *NOLLE PROSEQUI* due to the absence of evidence of any kind implicating them except for the fact that their names were included in the list of "Magdalo Members".
- Of the 11 Accused, 4 had all charges against them dropped by way of *nolle prosequi* as approved by the AFP Special Adjudication Board [SAB] (indicated below). Hence, only 7 of the 11 are still technically pending trial now – but we are still awaiting the decision of the AFP SAB on our request for *nolle prosequi*.

### Group B: People of the Philippines versus Captain Ruperto Reaso PA, et al.

- For: Violation of: *AW 63 – Disrespect Toward the President, Vice President, Congress of the Philippines, or Secretary of National Defense; AW 64 – Disrespect Toward Superior Officer; AW 67 – Mutiny or Sedition; AW 96 – Conduct unbecoming an Officer & a gentleman; AW 97 – Conduct prejudicial to good order & military discipline*
- These Officers were present at Oakwood but were identified as "*not part of the core group of leaders*" of the mutiny. They were not indicted before the Makati RTC.
- Note: There were 61 Accused pending trial in this case -- only 54 pleaded guilty.

List of the 54 AFP Officers in the Reason case who were court-martialed, plea bargained, reversed their plea from not guilty to guilty of only 1 military offense (violation of AW 97) and were adjudged guilty and sentenced by AFP GCM Nr 1.

The verdict and sentence were approved by the President on June 12, 2007.

**The verdict and sentence for the 54 Officers listed above is outlined below for ready reference.**

- I. **SENTENCE TO CONFINEMENT:** The Accused are sentenced to confinement in a detention facility or jail for a period of seven (7) years and six (6) months.
- II. **SENTENCE TO DISHONORABLE DISCHARGE:** Considering the seriousness of the offenses for which the Accused were indicted, and also considering that they are sentenced to serve time under confinement – factors that bring great dishonor to the noble profession of arms to which we all belong, and to the military establishment as a whole, the Accused are further sentenced to dishonorable discharge from the military service. The dishonorable discharge of the Accused from the military service shall be implemented only after they shall have completed in full their sentence to confinement. Furthermore, it should be noted that discharge from the military service of an Officer in the Armed Forces of the Philippines is effective only upon approval by the President and Commander-in-Chief.
- III. **PLACE OF CONFINEMENT:** The Accused shall serve their sentence to confinement in the same military detention facility where they are now confined.
- IV. **CREDIT FOR TIME SERVED:** The period of 3 years, 8 months & 14 days, which represents the time actually served already in confinement by the Accused, or since they were first deprived of their liberty on 28 July 2003, is hereby credited in full to the Accused. Being so credited, this period will be deducted from the total period still remaining during which the Accused shall remain in confinement.
- V. **3 MITIGATING CIRCUMSTANCES APPROVED.** The Court-Martial approved that 3 mitigating circumstances be considered in their favor so that one (1) year for each of the 3 mitigating circumstances is reduced from the time to be served by the Accused in confinement. Hence, the Accused must remain in confinement until their sentence is fully served at noon on 27 January 2008, at which time they shall be released from confinement – unless there will exist, at that time, another factual and/or legal reason for them not to be so released.
- VI. **Pay and allowances:** Under military law, only the President and Commander-in-Chief has the authority and prerogative to order the stoppage of payment of the pay and allowances of military officers. Without express instructions from the President and Commander-in-Chief thereon, this General Court-Martial will make no pronouncement on the matter, except that no changes in the status quo shall be made: those among the Accused Officers who are presently receiving their pay and allowances shall continue to do so unless and until otherwise directed by the President.



**Group C: People of the Philippines versus Captain Milo Maestrecampo PA, et al.**

- For AW 96 only (Conduct unbecoming an Officer and a gentleman). They were not indicted for any other military offense since they were all indicted before the Makati RTC for violation of Art. 134-A of the Revised Penal Code (i.e., for *coup d'etat*). In this way were avoided the possible complications that may arise from a claim of *double jeopardy*.


